Description

Scheme `sj` was previously the official scheme of the *Stata Journal*; see [\[R\] sj](#). The current official scheme is `stsj`; see [\[G-4\] Scheme st](#) for details.

Syntax

<i>schemename</i>	Foreground	Background	Description
<code>sj</code>	monochrome	white	previous official scheme for the <i>Stata Journal</i>

The current official scheme for the *Stata Journal* is `stsj`.

For instance, you might type

```
. graph ... , ... scheme(sj)
. set scheme sj [ , permanently ]
```
