Description

`st_ishname(s)` returns 1 if *s* contains a valid Stata name and 0 otherwise.

`st_ishlname(s)` returns 1 if *s* contains a valid Stata local-macro name and 0 otherwise.

Syntax

real scalar `st_ishname(string scalar s)`

real scalar `st_ishlname(string scalar s)`

Conformability

`st_ishname(s)`, `st_ishlname(s)`:

s: 1×1

result: 1×1

Diagnostics

`st_ishname(s)` aborts with error if *s* is a view (but `st_ishlname()` does not).
